Alberta Health Care Insurance

You need a health care card to get government paid health care services.

- Visit a registry to apply: www.health.alberta.ca/AHCIP/registration-locations.html
- Toll-free 403-310-0000 then 780-427-1432, www.health.alberta.ca
- Will grant one time 3 months extension while waiting for a new visa if called BEFORE current visa expires

Adults make health care decisions

- Tell doctors your health problems
- Ask questions if not sure
- Ask doctors of care choices/risks
- Be part of the healthcare team
- Make health care decisions

Doctor's duties

- Examine patients
- Answer patients' questions
- Tell patients the diagnosis
- Provide care/treatment choices
- Respect patients' health care decisions
- Keep patients' information confidential

Adults make health care decisions

Personal directives

Emergency departments:

- Treat life threatening health problems
- · Sickest patients are seen first

System with family doctors

- Annual check-up
- Detect growth/development
- Order medical tests
- Follow up with early pregnancy
