

Your Health Care Choices in Calgary & Area

811 Health Advice

- Health Information, Programs and Services
- Nurse, dietitian, doctor services over the phone
- 24/7, Free & Confidential, Interpretation available
- Can refer to the After-Hours Clinics / Virtual Doctor Service

After Hours Clinic

- 4 clinics in Calgary (NE/NW/SE/SW)
- Must call Health Link 811 first and then get a referral
- *Care determined by the nurse
- Minor pressing health needs (ex. Infection)
- Records sent back to your family doctor

Family Doctor

- Annual check-up
- Give advice & prevent illnesses
- Connecting with other doctors
- May have a nurse practitioner as your care provider
- How to find one: Search for a doctor near an address on www.albertafindadoctor.ca

Walk-In Clinic

- See a doctor when my family doctor is not available
- First come, first served
- Call 811 to find one / search online to find one
- Walk-in clinic visits cannot replace family doctor's services
- Only use when it is a minor concern (stitches, prescription refill, etc.)

Pharmacists

Always go to the same pharmacy



- Renew your prescription for current, ongoing therapy
- Review your dosage
- Assess cold/cough symptoms and offer treatment
- Help you with over-the-counter medications
- Give advice on vitamins/natural health products

Urgent Care Centre

- Minor emergency services (broken bones, stitches, infections)
- No appointment needed
- The sickest people are seen first

- South Calgary Health Centre, 31 Sunpark Plaza SE, Calgary, Open 8 am to 8 pm, 365 days a year

Surrounding Calgary,

- o Airdrie Community Health Centre, 604 Main Street S. Airdrie, Open 24/7
- o **Cochrane Community Health Centre**, 60 Grande Boulevard, Cochrane, Open 8 am to 10 pm, 365 days a year
- Okotoks Health and Wellness Centre, 11 Cimarron Common, Okotoks, Open 8 am to 10 pm, 365 days a year
- o For rural Alberta, call 811 to find an urgent care centre near your area.

TELUS Health MyCare App

- It can only be used on a mobile phone (Apple or Android)
- Symptom checker
- Video Chat meeting with a medical doctor (virtual walk-in clinic, need to book an appointment)
- Get a prescription or referral
- Free (AHC coverage, AB, BC and ON only), hours vary.
- You can get the record sent to my family doctor
- There are other services that are not free (dietician/counseling, etc.)

Over-The-Phone Health Care Interpreters -- Alberta Health Services

- Over-the-phone/zoom/video-chat interpretation (depends on availability)
- 24/7, in 240+ languages
- Ask a staff, confidential and free
