Breast Health Clinic

- breast cancer screening
- self / clinical exam, mammogram
- · breast health problems
- 1 in 8 women
- family doctor's referral

Pap test and colposcopy test

- · cervical cancer screening
- sexually active: 1st pap test at 25 or
- 3 years after having sex: e.g. 26+3= 1st pap test at 29
- then one test every 3 years until 69
- pap test: at family doctor / women's health clinics
- · colposcopy test: need family doctor's referral

AHS Obstetrics & Gynecology Services

- high risk pregnancy
- · meet with OB, gynaecologist
- get special / lab tests
- education
- · family doctor's referral

Menopause & Perimenopause

- No period for 1 year, around age 50, normal changes
- Perimenopause late 30~early 50, 2 to 8 years.
- Symptoms: irregular periods, hot flashes, insomnia, emotional changes, depression, headaches, heart beating too fast/unevenly, problems with



remembering or thinking clearly, vaginal dryness. Overtime, many improve or go away

• Healthy lifestyle helps: eat a nutritious diet, get regular exercise, limit caffeine, alcohol and stress, quit smoking. See a family doctor if anything changes / worsens.
